


Did you know?

The helmet shape on top of a cassowary's head is called a 'casque'. It is used by cassowaries to regulate their temperature so they don't get too hot or cold when quietly making their way through the dense rainforest. If you see a young (brown) cassowary with an adult (black) cassowary, the adult will be a male. That's because cassowary 'dads' raise the chicks once they hatch.
